Organized by artists Amy Wilson and Shannon Broder, this event was originally designed to help a group of friends weather the recession together. "Artists have been really devastated by the terrible economy. So we wanted to come up with a way to help ourselves to make a little extra money by selling inexpensive versions of our work – books, prints, multiples, whatever we can come up with," states Wilson.
