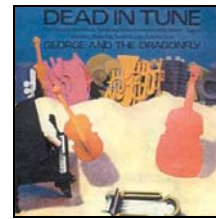

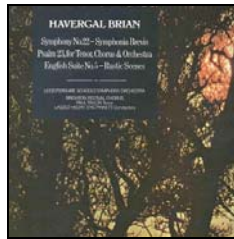

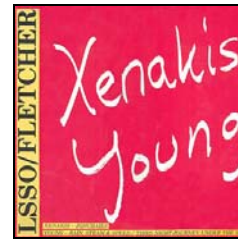

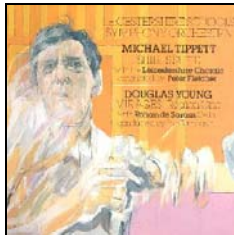

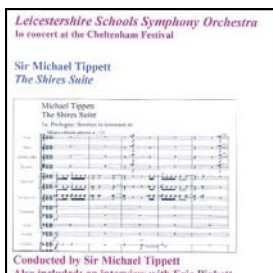

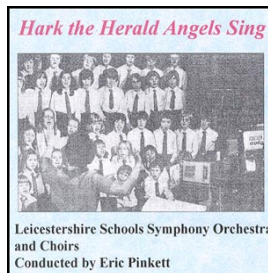

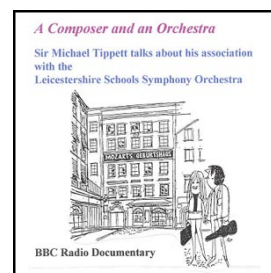

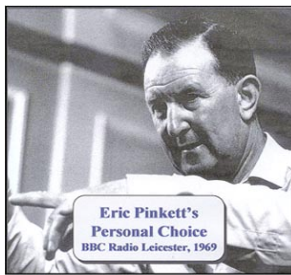

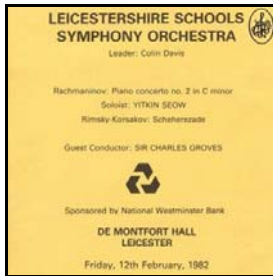

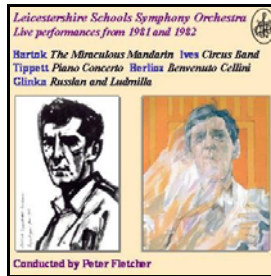

The LSSO and former players jointly perform Dvorak's *New World Symphony*.



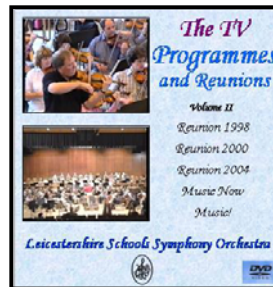

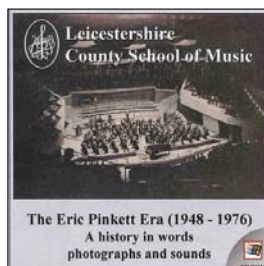
